Other Information you need to know

You can keep up to date with everything happening at the studio, and receive up to date information, by liking our Facebook page. Search for Black Swan Dance Company and click on the like button, and the follow button to receive a notification when ever we post.

Please note we do not allow parents to sit in or participate in any of our classes. (Other than Mums & Bubs) It is important that our students are able to concentrate and feel comfortable, and this can not always be achieved with parents and family watching in class. We do however offer Parent open days, which are always organised at the end of term one. If you have any concerns, or wish to discuss this, please do not hesitate in contacting Miss Danielle.

All classes are capped at between 15 -20 students in a class, and is dependant on the children's ages, abilities and number of teachers and/or class assistants.

At Black Swan Dance Company, we pride ourselves on providing up to date training which is age appropriate, and follows safe practises for the age and ability of our students. Our Company Director Miss Danielle is a qualified dance teacher and an associate of the Royal Academy of Dance holding a certificate in ballet teaching studies and an affiliate member of Australian Teachers of Dance. With over 12 years of teaching experience, and four years of owning a dance studio, you can feel at ease that our training is at the highest level. All of our teachers are experienced, and work closely with the studio director to ensure the tuition given in every one of our classes meet the requirements of each class and student.

All students who register for ballet classes Grade One through to Grade 5, are required to register for both classes a week. The Royal Academy of Dance set guidelines for minimum hours spent on each grade, to allow students the adequate time to safely develop the technique and learn the course work required to progress to the next grade.

Students registered for Intermediate-Foundation and over may be required to attend 3 classes a week (which is recommended by the RAD) the number of scheduled weekly classes may altered from term to term.

All students who are eligible to enter for ATOD or RAD examinations will now be required to attend extra exam classes, which are held shortly before the exam session. ATOD extra exam lessons will be held in June/July School Holidays. RAD extra exam classes will be held in Aug/Sept School Holidays. The number of classes are dependant on the age and level of student, and are charged at \$10.00 a lesson. Please consider these compulsory extra exam classes when choosing to do exams.

All students are invited to take part of our end of year annual concert. The concert is the highlight of the year, and is such a special experience for our dancers, and is something they will remember forever. Although we work hard to keep costs to a minimum, the concert is an added expense at an already expensive time of the year, and therefore it is not compulsory.
